You are invited to apply to become a member of the Daughters of Hawai'i, a non-profit organization founded in 1903 "to perpetuate the memory and spirit of old Hawai'i and of historic facts, and to preserve the nomenclature and correct pronunciation of the Hawaiian language." As a member you will help support:

If you have a relative who is a Daughter of Hawai'i, you can use her documentation of ancestry to submit with your application. ***It is very important that our Membership Committee is able to clearly delineate a direct lineage to the qualifying ancestor indicated on your application.*** If you have no ancestral records available, we suggest researching family genealogies, church records or photos of gravestones, the State of Hawai'i Archives or the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints' Family History Center. ***Documentation must accompany your application.***

Each applicant must be sponsored by a Daughter of Hawai'i who knows the applicant personally. Your sponsor must sign your application and she will be responsible for getting the signatures of two other members.

The Daughters of Hawai'i has an annual membership drive. After being reviewed by the Membership Committee, applications are presented at a general business meeting before being formally approved by the Board of Directors. New members are formally inducted at our annual pā'ina.

Be sure to fully complete your application as it will become your permanent record. Your signature at the bottom of the application is how your name will be recorded in our membership file and in our membership database.
