

MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

The Daughters of Hawai'i was organized in 1903 by seven kama'āina women who feared for the loss of Hawaiian culture. The mission of the society is to perpetuate the memory and spirit of old Hawai'i and to preserve the Hawaiian language and Hawaiian sites.

The society's endeavors include restoring and maintaining for the benefit of the public two furnished palaces used by former Hawaiian Royalty: Queen Emma Summer Palace, Hānaiakamalama, in Honolulu's Nu'uau Valley; and Hulihe'e Palace, in Kailua-Kona on Hawai'i island. Members pay an annual or a lifetime fee and are encouraged to participate in volunteer activities and attend meetings, usually historical in nature.

A person is eligible for membership if she is descended from an ancestor who was a resident of Hawai'i prior to the year 1880.
